AUTHORITATIVE PARENTING

- Creativity
- Life satisfaction
- Problem-solving abilities
- Self-esteem
- Emotional regulation
- Self-reliance
- Relationships
- Self-confidence



AUTHORITARIAN PARENTING

- Act fearful or overly shy
- Associate obedience and success with love
- Aggressive behavior toward others
- Fewer prosocial behaviors
- Have lower self-esteem
- Have more negative symptoms
- Struggle with self-control

PERMISSIVE PARENTING

- Display low achievement
- Make poor decisions
- May be more prone to delinquency
- Show more aggression
- Less emotional understanding
- Unable to manage their time or habits



UNINVOLVED PARENTING

- Be anxious or stressed due to the lack of family support
- Be emotionally withdrawn
- Fear becoming dependent on other people
- Increased risk of substance abuse
- Learn to provide for themselves
- Exhibit more delinquency
